The main responsibilities of a Pharmacy Technician involve getting the right medication to the right patient, and educating the patient on how to use it properly.

You'll take prescription orders, transcribe orders, calculate doses, work with drug distribution systems, prepare, pack, and label medications, and ensure that patients understand what they've been given and how to use it.

What careers are available after I graduate?

Pharmacy Technicians work in retail pharmacies, hospitals, pharmaceutical companies, home infusion organizations, and HMOs.
